Thank you for your interest in San Diego State University School of Nursing. The School of Nursing offers a graduate curriculum leading to a Master of Science Degree in Nursing. There are currently four concentrations of study: 1) Advanced Practice Nursing of Adults and Elderly; 2) Community Health Nursing; 3) Nursing Education; and 4) Nursing Leadership and Healthcare Systems.

Students in Advanced Practice Nursing of Adults and the Elderly Concentration are prepared as nurse practitioners and clinical nurse specialists **or** as clinical nurse specialists and nurse educators.

Students in the Community Health Nursing Concentration specialize in School Nursing, Community Health, Nurse-Midwifery or Nurse Midwifery and Women's Healthcare Nurse Practitioner, or Women's Healthcare Nurse Practitioner.

Students in the Nursing Education Concentration select advanced clinical content in one specialty: 1) Adult Health; 2) Maternal-Newborn; or 3) Nursing Leadership; 4) Pediatric Nursing
