Temporary alternative work is offered as a means of lessening the personal and financial strain that injuries often have on employees. We will cooperate fully with you in developing job modifications or tasks that allow our employee to return to work without compromising his/her physical condition.

San Diego State University encourages release to modified or temporary work assignments as soon as possible after the injury. We are eager to work within the limitations you may specify. We also recognize that there are times when temporary modified work may not be possible. In the cases where we are able to provide temporary modified duties, we will work to ensure that our employee adheres to all restrictions, limitations and therapies you deem necessary. Our goal is to return our employee to full and unrestricted work as quickly as possible.
